2.1 On 10 December 2021, Emergency Committee resolved:

“Agree to postpone the date of the Council meeting from 14 December 2021 to 25 January 2022 (thus displacing Licensing committee to 1 February 2022).”

### 3 ISSUES

3.1 The meeting of Licensing Committee took place on 1 February 2022, and committee resolved to approve the draft renewal of the cumulative impact policy for Whalley and Painterwood, to be used for consultation. That consultation is now taking place, however, there is insufficient time for this to be completed in time for the meeting on 22 March 2022. It is proposed therefore that the meeting be moved to 12 April 22 (being the next available date for the meeting and availability of the chair), so that the consultation can be completed, and the matter considered by committee. The matter is urgent as if approved the policy will need to be approved also by Council before it expires at the end of April 2022.
